- Tee times start at **8:30 AM** – Sign up for the event at the Premier Golf website: <http://premiergc.com/-jefferson-park-mens-club>. Please use the notes field in the electronic entry to request preferred starting position & pairings.
- 2-Man Scramble Format – Gross and Net. Pro Shop payout.
 - \$20 entry fee per JPMGC member.
 - \$30 entry fee per Guest.
 - Entries accepted as teams of **Two** players.
JPMGC + JPMGC = \$40 Entry.
JPMGC + Guest = \$50 Entry.
Guest + Guest = \$60 Entry.
- Handicaps: 35% of low handicap, 15% of high handicap.
 - Players with no GHIN or recognized handicap play as Zero index. If you need assistance establishing a handicap, then please contact Ross Wilson at rosswilson@hotmail.com.
- Side Game – Team Closest to the Pin on ALL par 3s. Cash payout.
 - \$20 cash entry fee **per team**.

Rules

1. All play from the **White Tees**.
2. Each player tees off, the best tee shot is selected and all players play their second shots from that spot. The best second shot is determined, and then all play their third shots from that spot, and so on until the ball is holed. This procedure continues until the ball is holed out and for all 18 holes (Note: All balls are lift clean and place). At the end of each hole, one member records the Gross score. They also sign the scorecard at the end of the round. There is only one Gross score per hole.
3. Except for the green and hazards, the team is allowed no more than one club length, no closer to the hole. The club length cannot substantially change or alter the original lie of the ball (i.e. chosen ball is in the rough, then play from the rough). Team members are allowed to rake for each shot out of a Bunker.
4. On the green, the Team is allowed to place the ball within 6 inches, no closer to the hole. Team members may stand in line of putt.
5. Please exchange scorecards with the other team in your group.
6. Local Rules are in effect, listed on back of course scorecard.
7. Staked trees, please take relief according to Rule 25-1 B.
8. In the event of a ball coming to rest in an area damaged by the maintenance crew please take relief according to Rule 25-1 B.
