## Gross and Net Club Champions will be crowned!

- 36-Hole Medal Play 2-Day, Saturday & Sunday Format – First Tee Time **7:30 AM** Both Days
- \$40 Entry Fee due at time of registration [Online](#) or at the Pro Shop
  - Entry fee includes Credit Payout, KPs, Long Drives, and Range Balls each day
  - Green fees and power cart not included
- Green fee payment for Saturday & Sunday rounds will be collected at check-in Saturday
  - Saturday pairings requests will be accepted. Sunday pairings set from Saturday gross scores with high scores teeing off first Sunday morning. The last tee time Sunday will be the lowest scoring players from Round 1. Saturday Tee times will be posted online and sent via email. Sunday tee times will be posted online, sent via email, and posted in the clubhouse after Round 1 is completed.
- Green fees will be reduce to the Premier GC Platinum Level of 20% discount

**KP: Ball Must be on the Green – LD: Ball Must Be in the Fairway**

- Side Games – Gross & Net Skins by Division Each Day.
  - Cash \$10 buy-in each day, cash payout
  - Players may enter Saturday, Sunday, or both days
- All play from the **Blue Tees**
- All players are required to exchange scorecards with a playing partner
  - Record All Gross Scores Only
  - Scorecard Must Be Signed & Attested
- **Play the Ball as it lies! Hands off!**
  - Rule 9 – Ball Played as It Lies; Ball at Rest Lifted or Moved

- **Local Rules are in effect**
  - Listed on back of Jefferson Park Golf Course scorecard.
  - Staked trees shall be considered Abnormal Conditions and players should take relief according to [Rule 16-1](#) *if and only if* the staked tree interferes with swing or stance.
- In the event of an embedded ball take relief under [Rule 16-3](#).
- In the event of a ball coming to rest in an area damaged by the maintenance crew that ground shall be considered Abnormal Conditions and players should take relief according to [Rule 16-1](#).
- In the event of a ball coming to rest in casual water and or mud that ground shall be considered Abnormal Conditions and players should take relief according to [Rule 16-1](#)
